## **SUMMARY**

In November 2017 Sea Delight commissioned a pre-assessment, based on Marine Steardship Council (MSC) standards for sustainable fisheries, of the Vietnam swordfish handline fishery.

The Viernam Handline Swordfish FIP will work in cooperation with and contribute to the ongoing work in the Vietnam Tuna Handline FIP, the "parent fishery" of the swordfish handline fishery. The FIP work plan focuses on activities to create a swordfish management plan.
